BRIEF SUMMARY

Main Characteristics of the Vineyards

Located in the Andes Mountains between 1.720 – 2.206 m.a.s.l. in Alcohuz, Elqui Valley, Chile. This is an area of great luminosity and clean blue skies.

Characteristics of the Vintage

Winter–Spring 2014: annual rainfall was 57 mm. (below average).

On the 12th. June 31 cm. of snow fell in the vineyards.

Summer 2015: the summer was very dry, with no rain at all.

Average maximum summer temperature for the warmest month (January) was 24,7°C, and the average minimum was 8,7°C. For the area it was a much cooler year than normal.
