BRIEF SUMMARY

Vineyards Main Characteristics

Located in the Andes Mountains between 1.720 – 2.206 m.a.s.l. in Alcohuz, Elqui Valley, Chile. This is an area of great luminosity and clean blue skies.

Vintage Characteristics

Winter-Spring 2012: Annual rainfall was 6,9 mm, one of the lowest in history. There was no snow or frost in the vineyards.

Summer 2013: The summer was dry, with no rain at all. Average maximum summer temperature for the warmest month (January) was 29,1°C, and the average minimum was 13°C.
