BRIEF SUMMARY

Main Characteristics of the Vineyards

Located in the Andes Mountains at 1.788 m.a.s.l. in Alcohuz, Elqui Valley, Chile. This is an area of great luminosity and clean blue skies.

Characteristics of the Vintage

Winter-Spring 2014: Annual rainfall was 57 mm. (below average).

On the 12th. June 31 cm. of snow fell in the vineyards.

Summer 2015: The summer was very dry, with no rain at all. Average maximum summer temperature for the warmest month (January) was 24,7°C, and the average minimum was 8,7°C. For the area it was a much cooler year than normal.
