## **BRIEF SUMMARY**

## Main Characteristics of the Vineyards

Located in the Andes Mountains at 1.788 m.a.s.l. in Alcohuaz, Elqui Valley, Chile. This is an area of great luminosity and clean blue skies.

## Characteristics of the Vintage

Winter-Spring 2014: Annual rainfall was 57 mm. (below average).

On the 12<sup>th.</sup> June 31 cm. of snow fell in the vineyards.

<u>Summer 2015</u>: The summer was very dry, with no rain at all. Average maximum summer temperature for the warmest month (January) was 24,7°C, and the average minimum was 8,7°C. For the area it was a much cooler year than normal.
