## BRIEF SUMMARY

### Vineyards Main Characteristics

Located in the Andes Mountains at 1.788 m.a.s.l. in Alcohuz, Elqui Valley, Chile. This is an area of great luminosity and clean blue skies.

### Vintage Characteristics

Winter–Spring 2015: Annual rainfall was 179 mm., a rainy year for this area.

It fell in total 62 cm of snow, 32 cm on 14<sup>th</sup> October with shoots of more than 20 cm on average within the vineyard, as a consequence burned the buds. We only harvested 18% of the expected volume of grapes.

Summer 2016: The summer was very dry, with no rain at all. Average maximum summer temperature for the warmest month (January) was 28,6°C, and the average minimum was 12,8°C.
